

Knoch Knolls Park Hike

Knoch Knolls Park in Naperville has a large area of Virginia Bluebells that bloom during the first part of May. They should be at their peak around May. If we catch them at their peak, they should be spectacular. The length of this easy hike will be about 3 miles and should take about an hour. There will be an option for a longer hike, for those who want to extend their hike on nearby hiking trails. Also, a brand new Nature Center has opened up at Knoch Knolls which hikers can visit after the hike. If there's light rain we'll still take a walk, in the case of heavy rain or seriously inclement weather, the event will be cancelled. There are picnic tables if you would like to have an optional lunch after the hike.
