

Lake Geneva Autumn Hike

Everyone is invited to join us on Sunday, October 15, for the Prairie Club's annual eleven-mile hike halfway around Lake Geneva, Wisconsin. We will begin at the Abbey Resort in Fontana, Wisconsin and walk the trail to downtown Lake Geneva (we have found parking is easier at the Resort). This public access trail which was named one of the Ten Most Beautiful Trails in the Midwest, consists of wood, earth, stone and brick as each property owner is responsible for maintaining their portion of the trail. Our hike takes us past magnificent homes and gardens on one side and a continual view of sparkling Lake Geneva on the other side. Hopefully, the autumn leaves will be at their peak. For those walkers desiring a shorter walk, it is safe and impossible to get lost if you walk part way and turn back early. Our destination will be the charming town of Lake Geneva, Wisconsin where a car will be parked to shuttle walkers back to The Abbey. The Abbey Resort is located on the West end of Geneva Lake at 269 Fontana Blvd, Fontana, WI 53125. We shall meet at 10:30 a.m. in front of the main entrance of The Abbey Resort, Please bring a sack lunch, plenty of water, sunscreen, sun hat, and wear comfortable shoes for walking.
