Who: Club members and their guests, to be eligible to use the Club kayaks and paddle boards, must

- 1) Be at least 12 years old
- 2) Able to swim to the sand bar and back
- Submit a signed liability waiver, signed by parents or legal guardians for boaters under age 18, to the Waterfront Director or to the Beach Chair at <u>rwlutter@gmail.com</u>
- 4) Have sufficient prior knowledge and experience and
- 5) Seek advice as necessary from the Waterfront Director or the Beach Chair about selecting and donning a personal flotation device.

Where: Equipment is stored in the Hazelhurst boating area by the orange sign "Club Boats" and by the stand for the Waterfront Director.
