Camp Hazelhurst Camp Vice-Chair

The Prairie Club (Club) is a non-profit, volunteer organization founded in 1908. Position, Term and Responsibilities of the Camp Hazelhurst Camp Vice-Chair

The Camp Hazelhurst Camp Vice-Chair is an elected position by the Camp Hazelhurst siteholders for a term of two years. The two year term generally runs concurrently with the term of the Camp Hazelhurst Camp Chair. At the end of the two year term, the Vice-Chair becomes the Camp Hazelhurst Camp Chair.

The major responsibilities of the Camp Hazelhurst Camp Vice-Chair include:

- Performs Camp Hazelhurst Camp Chair duties and responsibilities when the Camp Chair is not available
- Attends Prairie Club Board of Directors meetings if the Camp Chair is unable to attend. At those meetings, the Vice-Chair is to participate in the discussion but cannot vote on matters before the Board of Directors
- Works closely with the Camp Hazelhurst Camp Chair, other Camp Committee members and the Camp Hazelhurst Property Manager
- Participates closely with the Camp Chair to develop and implement transition plans
- Performs other responsibilities as assigned by the Camp Chair
