Morton Arboretum was established in 1922, and now encompasses 1,700 acres and 16 miles of hiking trails. The Arboretum claims to have over 200,000 daffodils on their grounds, so find out if it is true. Hopefully, dogwood and viburnum are still be in bloom and also spring beauties, hepatica and other wildflowers.

We will meet in front of the visitors center at 10:00 AM for and will hike approx. 2 hours. (or longer if you wish). The charge for entry to the Arboretum for non-members is \$14.00 adult / \$12.00 senior. (The Arboretum also has reciprocity with some other horticultural gardens.) Please bring plenty of water, sun protection, and comfortable walking shoes.

There will be an optional lunch after the hike at noon at the Visitor Center's Ginko Cafe for those interested.
